

## NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 19th May, 2010

**G.S.R. 424(E).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Joint Secretary Recruitment Rules, 2002 the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Joint Secretary in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement-** (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Joint Secretary Recruitment Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay/scale of pay-** The number of the said post, its classification and the pay band and grade pay/ scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule, annexed hereto.

**3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification, etc. -** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said schedule.

**4. Disqualification. -** No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax. -** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reason to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the Orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

		<p>(b) possessing fifteen years' experience including five years' in Parliamentary or Legislative functions.</p> <p>(II) Departmental Director in the scale of pay of Rs. 37400-67000 with grade pay of Rs. 8700 in PB-4 with three years regular service in the grade will also be considered along with the outsider. If selected, the post would be deemed to have been filled by promotion.</p> <p>The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.</p> <p>(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.)</p> <p>Note: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January of 2006/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission. For purposes of appointment on deputation/ absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January of 2006/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade, without any upgradation.</p>
