**1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-**

**A) Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

At the end of the month of April, 2024, 677 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 658 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending. During the month, 17 Assurances were added at the instance of committee on Government Assurances Lok Sabha while 15 Assurances were added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurances Rajya Sabha..

**B) Follow up action on Matters raised under Rule 377 in Lok Sabha and Matters raised by way of Special Mention in Rajya Sabha**

**C) Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes**

- An intra-school essay competition on Swachhata theme was organised for students of Kerala Sr. Sec. School, Vikaspuri on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 during Swachhata Pakhwada.
- The 4<sup>th</sup> edition of NYPS was launched and registration for the 4<sup>th</sup> edition started from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2024

- In the month of April, 2024 total 81 new registrations from various Educational institutions were made on the NYPS portal. 34 institutions have fully or partially uploaded photographs, videos, report, student details etc on NYPS portal after conducting the Youth Parliament sitting.

#### **D) National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)**

During the month of April, 2024 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

##### **i. Rajasthan became the 24th legislature in the country to sign MoU with MoPA to adopt NeVA**

Rajasthan signed a MoU with the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs on 29th April, 2024 to transform itself into a digital house by embracing NeVA.

##### **ii. Audit of NeVA Project of Meghalaya**

The Internal Audit Wing of the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions has completed Audits of the NeVA Project at the Meghalaya Assembly. The audits were conducted from 29th April to 3rd May at Meghalaya Legislative Assembly.

#### **E) Celebration of Swachhata Pakhwada – 2024**

The Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs celebrated Swachhata Pakhwada from 16th to 30th April 2024. This was celebrated as per the Calendar of Swachhata Pakhwada for the year 2024, released by the Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation, Government of India. The Swachhata Pakhwada commenced with administering of 'Swachhata Pledge' by Secretary, Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs on 16th April, 2024. During Swachhata Pakhwada, cleanliness drive was carried out and reviewing, recording and weeding out of old Physical Files were done by various Sections of the Ministry and old and obsolete items were identified for auction. Cleaning and regular maintenance of rooms and appliances were also carried out in ministry offices located in Samvidhan Sadan. As part of the programme, Swachhata Pledge was administered to students of Kerala Senior Secondary School, Vikaspuri to spread awareness and develop a culture of cleanliness. An essay competition was also held in the school and winners were awarded with cash prizes with certificates. Swachhata Pakhwada, 2024 concluded with Prize Distribution to top three Sections of the Ministry who stood best on Swachhata Parameters.
