VII. Meeting of Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs in its meeting

held on 19th August, 2024, considered Notes No.05/2024 and 06/2024 dated the 19th August, 2024 and decided that:

- i. the Budget Session, 2024 (2nd Session of 18th Lok Sabha and 265th Session of Rajya Sabha), which was **adjourned sine-die on Friday, the 9th August, 2024, be prorogued (both Houses- Note No. 5 of 2024)**. Thereafter, decision of CCPA was communicated to Lok Sabha/Rajya Sabha Secretariats and notifications in this respect were issued by them after obtaining approval of the President.
- ii. Cases of Government's Stand on Private Members Bills and Resolutions for being "**Opposed or for requesting/persuading the Members concerned to withdraw the Bills/Resolutions falling which they may be opposed/not to support**", which were approved by the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs under the power delegated to him were ratified. (Note No. 06 of 2024)

B) National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) for 'Digital Legislatures':

1) Inauguration of National e-Vidhan application (NeVA) in Assam Legislative Assembly on 12th August, 2024

NeVA was inaugurated in Assam Vidhan Sabha by Sh. Hemant Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble Chief Minister on 12th August, 2024 in Dispur, Guwahati. The Additional Secretary, MoPA also attended the inauguration event. Moreover, training was also provided to the Hon'ble Ministers, Members and the Assembly officials on various modules of NeVA.

2) Visit of Secretary, MoPA and Additional Secretary, MoPA to Andhra Pradesh for discussion on implementations of NeVA Project in the Legislature

The Secretary, MoPA and the Additional Secretary, MoPA visited Andhra Pradesh Legislature on 30th August, 2024 to hold a discussion on NeVA with the officials of the Legislature for its speedy implementation in Andhra Pradesh.

3) Meeting with the officials of Bihar Council on future scope of NeVA implementation

The Secretary, MoPA chaired a meeting with the Secretary, Bihar Council and other officials of the Bihar Council on 13th August, 2023 in Parliament House, New Delhi on future scope/roadmap for completion of NeVA project in the Council.

4) Meeting with the officials of U.P Council for discussion on Supplementary DPR

A meeting of the Additional Secretary, MoPA along with the other officials of MoPA was held with the officials of U.P. Council on 22nd August, 2024 in the chamber of the Additional Secretary, MoPA for discussion on the various aspects of the supplementary DPR submitted by them.

5) Audit of NeVA Project of Tripura Legislative Assembly

The internal Audit wing of Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions had conducted the Audit of the NeVA Project in Tripura Legislative Assembly from 5th Aug - 9th Aug, 2024.

6) Release of funds to State Legislature

1. The 1st Instalment of Central share of NeVA Project amounting to Rs.2,32,32,492/- (Rs. Two crore thirty two lakh thirty two thousand four ninety two) was released to Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly on 16th August, 2024 for implementation of NeVA.

2. The 2nd instalment of Central share of NeVA Project amounting to Rs.5,01,99,624/- (Rs. Five crore one lakh ninety nine thousand six hundred twenty four) was released to Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly on 14th August, 2024 for implementation of NeVA.

7) Live House Sessions held through NeVA

1. The Autumn Session of Manipur Legislative Assembly was held through 1st August, 2024 to 12th august, 2024.
2. The Budget session of Sikkim Legislative Assembly was held from 5th August, 2024 to 9th August, 2024.
3. The Monsoon Session of Gujarat Legislative Assembly was conducted from ^{21st} August, 2024 to 23rd August, 2024.
4. The first session of Assam Legislative Assembly was held through NeVA from 22nd to 30th August, 2024.
5. The Autumn Session of Meghalaya Legislative Assembly was held through NeVA from 23rd to 30th August, 2024.

8) Capacity Building Measures

A demonstration on Question Module was given to the officials of Uttarakhand Assembly through Video Conferencing on 6th August, 2024.

C) IMPLEMENTATION OF ASSURANCES IN PARLIAMENT

At the end of the month of August, 2024, 831 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 583 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending. During the month, 27 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 264 Assurances were added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurances, Lok Sabha while 44 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

During the month of August, 2024, 25 Implementations Reports were laid in Lok Sabha and 38 Implementations reports were laid in Rajya Sabha.

D) Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes

1. Decision was taken to organize the Prize Distribution Function of 56th Youth Parliament Competition, 2023-24 for Delhi Schools on 6th September, 2024.
2. Decision was taken to organize the Orientation Course of 17th National Youth Parliament Competition of 17th National Youth Parliament Competition, 2024-25 for universities/colleges on 25-26th September, 2024 at Munnar, Kerala.
3. In the month of **August, 2024, total 3124 new registrations from various Educational institutions** were made on the NYPS portal. 178 **institutions** have fully or partially uploaded photographs, videos, report, student details etc. on NYPS Portal after conducting the Youth Parliament sitting.

E) All-party meetings

On 6th August 2024, an all-party meeting of selected Leaders was convened by Hon'ble Minister of Parliamentary Affairs on the current situation of Bangladesh, which was chaired by Hon'ble Defense Minister. Minister of External Affairs briefed Leaders on the issue.
