**1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-**

**I. Meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs.**

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs held a meeting on Monday, the 8<sup>th</sup> of January, 2024, to consider Note No.01/2024 dated the 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 regarding summoning of Interim Budget Session, 2024 and approved that both Houses of Parliament may be summoned for its Interim Budget Session, 2024 on Wednesday, the 31<sup>st</sup> of January, 2024 and subject to exigencies of Government Business, the Session may conclude on Friday, the 9<sup>th</sup> of February, 2024.

**II. Interim Budget Session 2024 (15<sup>th</sup> Session of Seventeenth Lok Sabha and 263<sup>rd</sup> Session of Rajya Sabha) Commenced.**

**III. Delivery of President's Address.**

The President of India addressed Members of the two Houses of Parliament assembled together in Lok Sabha Chamber on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2024
