





Subject: - Monthly summary for the month of June, 2024 of Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.

1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-

A. Important Legislative Business

I. Meeting of the Cabinet

1. The Cabinet in its meeting held on 05.06.2024, decided to advise the President to dissolve the Seventeenth Lok Sabha.
2. The Cabinet in its meeting held on 10th June, 2024, decided the following:-
 - i. Lok Sabha be convened on 24.06.2024, and the Rajya Sabha be convened on 27.06.2024 and subject to exigencies of Government Business, both the Houses of Parliament may conclude their Session on 03.07.2024.
 - ii. The election of the Speaker be held on 26.06.2024; and
 - iii. The President be requested to address both the Houses of Parliament assembled together in the Lok Sabha Chamber, Parliament House at 11.00 a.m. on 27.06.2024.

II. Dissolution of Seventeenth Lok Sabha

The President approved the decision of the Cabinet to dissolve 17th Lok Sabha on 05.06.2024, which was conveyed to Lok Sabha Secretariat and duly notified on the same day.

III. Appointment of Speaker, pro-tem and persons for oath/affirmation of new elected Members of Eighteenth Lok Sabha

The President appointed Sh. Bhartruhari Mahtab, as Speaker, *pro-tem* and Sh. Suresh Kodikunil, Sh. Thalikkottai Rajuthevar Baalu, Shri Radha Mohan Singh, Shri Faggan Singh Kulaste and Sh. Sudip Bandyopadhyay as persons before any of whom the new members may make and subscribe oath or affirmation. Sh. Bhartruhari Mahtab was administered oath/affirmation on 24.06.2024 at Rashtrapati Bhawan.

I V First Session of 18th Lok Sabha and 249th Session of Rajya Sabha commenced.

The First Session of 18th Lok Sabha commenced on 24th June, 2024 and the 264th Session of Rajya Sabha commenced on 27th June, 2024.

V. Oath or Affirmation.

The newly elected Members of 18th Lok Sabha took Oath or Affirmation on 24th, 25th and 26th June, 2024.

VI. Election of Speaker.

Election of Speaker, Lok Sabha was held on 26th June, 2024.

VII. Delivery of President's Address.

The President of India addressed the two Houses of Parliament assembled together in Lok Sabha Chamber of Parliament House on 27.06.2024.

B. Implementation of Assurances in Parliament

At the end of the month of June, 2024, 566 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 662 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending. During the month, 17 Assurances were added at the instance of the Committee on Government Assurances, Lok Sabha while 01 Assurance was added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurances, Rajya Sabha..

C. Follow up action on Matters raised under Rule 377 in Lok Sabha and Matters raised by way of Special Mention in Rajya Sabha

Comprehensive guidelines were issued to all Ministries/Departments related to dealing with the issues raised under Rule 377 in the Lok Sabha and by way of Special Mentions in the Rajya Sabha vide O.M.No.14/1/2020-Leg-II dated 18.06.2024.

D. Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes

- Decision was taken to organize the Orientation Course of 57th Youth Parliament Competition, 2023-24 for Delhi Schools on 5th July, 2024 in digital mode.
- Decision was taken to organize the Orientation Course of 35th National Youth Parliament Competition, 2023-24 for Kendriya Vidyalaya on 12th July, 2024 in digital mode.
- Decision was taken to organize the Orientation Course of 26th National Youth Parliament Competition, 2023-24 for JNVs on 19th July, 2024 in digital mode.

- In the month of June, 2024 total 183 new registrations from various Educational institutions were made on the NYPS portal.

E. National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)

During the month of June, 2024 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

1) MEETING OF EMPOWERED COMMITTEE OF NeVA TO GRANT SANCTION FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF NeVA PROJECT IN RAJASTHAN

The 14th meeting of empowered committee of NeVA was held under the chairmanship of Secretary, MPA on 5th June, 2024 to approve the DPR for implementation of NeVA Project in Rajasthan Legislative Assembly. The Committee granted sanction for the NeVA Project in Rajasthan Legislative Assembly with a Project outlay of Rs. **12,61,60,250/-**.

2) MoU SIGNED WITH MADHYA PRADESH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 3RD JUNE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF NeVA PROJECT UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY

The Principal Secretary, Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly and the Additional Secretary, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh had visited the Parliament House, New Delhi to sign a tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with MoPA in the presence of Secretary, MoPA and the Additional Secretary, MoPA along with the other officials on 3rd June, 2024 for implementation of NeVA Project in the State.

3) RELEASE OF FUNDS FOR LEGISLATURE

The 1st Instalment of Central Government's share of Grants-in -Aid amounting to Rs. 2,68,42,644/- (Rupees Two Crore Sixty Eight Lakh Forty Two Thousand Six Hundred Forty Four) was released to Assam Legislative Assembly on 6th June, 2024 for implementation of NeVA.

4) LIVE HOUSE SESSIONS HELD THROUGH NeVA

During this month, the online support was rendered to the following Legislatures by CPMU, NeVA team for hassle-free conduction of their sessions live through NeVA.

- (i) The Budget Session of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly was held from 20th June,2024 to 29th June,2024.
- (ii) A one-day session of 11th Sikkim Legislative Assembly was held on

12th June, 2024 for administering oath/affirmation to the Members of the Assembly.

5) CAPACITY BUILDING MEASURES

(i) An introductory workshop for the officials of Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly on NeVA was held on 11th June, 2024 through VC under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary. The officials were briefed about the working of the complete NeVA suite comprising various Modules.

(ii) The officials of Mizoram Legislative Assembly were provided a virtual training on 'Committee module' on 12th June, 2024.

F. Notification of Leader of Opposition in the House of People

A notification was published on 27.06.2024 in the Gazette of India notifying Shri Rahul Gandhi as Leader of Opposition in the House of People for the purposes of the Salary and Allowances of Leaders of Opposition in Parliament Act, 1977.
