



**1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-**

**A. Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

At the end of the month of May, 2024, 675 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 661 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending.

**B. Workshop on Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace**

A Workshop on Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 was organized on 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.

#### D. Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes

- The result of 56<sup>th</sup> National Youth Parliament Competition for Delhi Schools, 2023-24 was declared on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2024. M. M. Public School, Pitampura, Delhi has been declared winner of the competition at National Level.
- In the month of May, 2024, total 50 new registrations from various Educational Institutions were made on the NYPS Portal. 3 institutions have fully or partially uploaded photographs, videos, report, student details etc. on NYPS Portal after conducting the Youth Parliament sitting.

#### E. National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)

During the month of May, 2024 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

- **Meeting of empowered committee of NeVA to grant sanction for implementation of NeVA project in Assam**

The 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of Empowered Committee of NeVA was convened under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MoPA on 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 to sanction the implementation of NeVA project in Assam Legislative Assembly. The Committee approved the implementation of the project in Assam Legislative Assembly with a project outlay of Rs **14, 91, 58, 600** /-.

- **Audit for CMS portal, Public Portal and iOS**

Audit for CMS Portal, Public Portal and iOS Public Portal Mobile Application has been completed, thereby, further augmenting the NeVA software suite.

- **Bhashini and NeVA partnership for text translation**

Text-to-text translation services have been successfully incorporated in CMS Module, LoB Module and Question Processing Module of NeVA application with the help of APIs shared by BHASHINI, MeitY.

- **Meeting to review status of NeVA implementation in live States**

A Virtual meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2024 was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MoPA to review the status of project implementation in the state legislatures that have already gone live on NeVA. Apart from the 13 state legislatures that are already live on the application, Odisha Legislative Assembly which is in the final stages of going live on the application, participated in the meeting.

- a. Training on NeVA Modules was given to Uttarakhand and Meghalaya Legislative Assemblies from 20<sup>th</sup> May,2024 to 22<sup>nd</sup> May,2024
