- (iii) The 11th Session of Seventeenth Lok Sabha and 259th Session of Rajya Sabha(Budget Session, 2023) adjourned for recess on Monday, the 13th February, 2023 to reassemble on Monday, 13th March, 2023.

• Implementation of Assurances in Parliament

During the month of February, 2023, 22 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceeding and 25 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

- d. Kendriya Vidyalaya, AFS Manauri, Prayagraj (U.P.) has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav 21st February, 2023.
- e. Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Amravati, Maharashtra has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 18th February, 2023.
- f. Andhra Education Society Senior Secondary School, Prasad Nagar, Karol Bagh has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 13th February, 2023.

- **National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)**

During the month of February , 2023 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

- 1. Visit by officials from CPMU NeVA to Rajasthan Assembly**

- a. 3 officials from CPMU NeVA Assembly visited Rajasthan Assembly, Jaipur on 06th Feb 2023, to hold a meeting with Secretary, Rajasthan Assembly and other officials to give them a firsthand knowledge about NeVA platform. The meeting resulted in Secretary's order to adopt various modules of NeVA in Rajasthan Assembly.

- 2. 3 day Virtual meeting conducted by Secretary, MoPA**

- a. The virtual meeting to review the progress status of National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) in Legislative Assemblies of Bihar, Puducherry, Sikkim, Tripura, Odisha, Punjab, Manipur & Jharkhand was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs (MoPA), GOI from 15th – 17th Feb, 2023.

- 3. Visit by officials from CPMU NeVA to Haryana Assembly**

- a. 2 officials from CPMU NeVA Assembly visited Haryana Assembly, Chandigarh from 20th Feb, 2023 to 23th Feb, 2023 so as to assist the Assembly to successfully run their session using NeVA platform.
- b. The Haryana Vidhan Sabha presented its budget and Governor's address through NeVA platform in paperless mode during its Budget Session. This has resulted in much lower consumption of papers as compared to pre-NeVA times.
- c. Training was also given to MLAs and officials so as to enable them to effectively use NeVA application.

- a. 2 officials from CPMU NeVA Assembly visited UP Council, Lucknow on 20th Feb, 2023 to 23th Feb, 2023 so as to assist the Assembly to successfully run their budget session using NeVA platform.
- b. NeVA platform was used in various legislative processes of Council during the budget session.

5. Video Conferencing workshop

- a. Central Project Monitoring Unit, NeVA conducted an online workshop cum training program for Tripura Assembly on 27th - 28th Feb, 2023 to give training in various modules of NeVA and to resolve the issues faced by the officials of Assembly with respect to the NeVA platform.
- b. CPMU NeVA also organised an online meeting through video conferencing on 28th Feb. 2023 for Andhra Pradesh Legislature to give an introduction about NeVA project. The meeting was attended by Secretary, IT, Andhra Pradesh Govt. and officials from Andhra Pradesh Legislature.
