1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-

The first part of 8<sup>th</sup> Session of Seventeenth Lok Sabha and 256<sup>th</sup> Session of Rajya Sabha (Budget Session, 2022) adjourned for recess on Friday, the 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 to reassemble on Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.

• **Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

From 1956 to January, 2022 a total of 97054 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57107 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 1094 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 607 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of February, 2022, 20 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 26 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

During the month of February, 2022, 112 Implementation Reports were laid in Lok Sabha and 49( 01 Part) Implementation Reports were laid in Rajya Sabha.

• **Functioning of Consultative Committees**

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees is advisory. At present 38 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

In the month of February, 2022 –

- a. 4 meetings of Consultative Committee were held during this month.
- b. Name of one Member of Parliament was deleted from a Consultative Committee

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after his death during this month.
