**1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-**

• **Meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs**

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs held a meeting on Thursday, the 02<sup>nd</sup> November, 2023 to consider Note No. 09/2023 dated 02<sup>nd</sup> November, 2023 regarding summoning of Winter Session, 2023 and approved that both Houses of Parliament may be summoned for its Winter Session, 2023 on Monday, the 4<sup>th</sup> of December, 2023 and subject to exigencies of Government Business, the Session may conclude on Friday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> of December, 2023.

• **Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

At the end of the month of November, 2023, 787 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 675 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending. During the month, 48 Assurances were added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurances Lok Sabha while 02 Assurances were added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurances Rajya Sabha.
