1. Live session of Punjab on NeVA project-

Punjab Legislative Assembly ran its 4<sup>th\*</sup> session via NEVA platform from 20th October, 2023. Various NeVA modules such as LOB, Digital House etc. were used during the session. Necessary support was given by CPMU NeVA to the Punjab Assembly for successfully running the House on NeVA platform.

- 2. Video Conferencing based workshop-
- a.CPMU NeVA Team organised a Virtual Conference with Haryana Legislative Assembly for the Digitalization of legacy records via Digital Archival NeVA on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.
- b. CPMU NeVA Team organised a Virtual Conference with Punjab Legislative Assembly for the discussion on Notice Module on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2023. CPMU NeVA Team also organised a Virtual Conference for Training and Demonstrating the Reporter Module and Time Management Display Screen (Digital House Module) on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.
