1. Important Policy Decisions and major achievements during the month

- The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs in its meeting held on Monday, the 10th January, 2022 decided that
 - a) Both Houses of Parliament may be summoned for the Budget Session, 2022 on 31st January, 2022 and subject to the exigencies of Government Business, the session may conclude on 8th April, 2022.
 - b) Both Houses of Parliament may be adjourned for recess on Friday, 11th February 2022, to reassemble on Monday, 14th March, 2022
 - c) The Hon'ble President may address both Houses of Parliament assembled together on 31st January, 2022, and
 - d) The Union Budget for 2022-23 may be presented in Lok Sabha on Tuesday, the 1st February, 2022 at 1100 hours and after presentation of the Budget, the respective Houses may be adjourned for the day.

- Commencement of Budget Session, 2022

The Budget Session 2022 (8th Session of Seventeenth Lok Sabha and 256th Session of Rajya Sabha) commenced on 31st January, 2022.

- Delivery of President's Address

The Hon'ble President of India addressed the Members of the two Houses of Parliament assembled together on 31.01.2022 at 11:00 AM.

- Implementation of Assurances in Parliament

From 1956 to December, 2021 a total of 97039 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57097 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 1215 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 584 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of January, 2022, 15 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 10 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

- Functioning of Consultative Committees

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees

is advisory. At present 37 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

- a) Two Members of Parliament have been nominated on various Consultative Committees by the Government.
