- **Meeting of the Cabinet Committee of Parliamentary Affairs**

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs in its meeting held on Thursday, the 7th April, 2022 decided that:-

1. The 8th Session of the 17th Lok Sabha (Budget Session -2022) and 256<sup>th</sup> Session of Rajya Sabha which were adjourned sine-die on Thursday, the 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 be prorogued.
2. Government's stand on Private Members Bills and Resolutions for being "Opposed or for requesting/persuading the Members concerned to withdraw the Bills/Resolution failing which they may be opposed /not to support", approved by the Minister for Parliamentary Affairs under the power delegated be ratified.

- **Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

From 1956 to March, 2022 a total of 97119 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57163 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 1146 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 719 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of April, 2022, 50 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 90 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

During the month of April, 2022, 42 Implementation Reports were laid in Lok Sabha and 28 Implementation reports were laid in Rajya Sabha.

- **Functioning of Consultative Committees**

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees is advisory. At present 39 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

In the month of March, 2022 –

- 14 Meetings of Consultative Committee were held.
- Names of 10 Member of Parliament have been deleted from various Consultative Committees after their death/Retirement during this month.
- 03 Members of Parliament nominated on various Consultative Committees by Government during the month.

- **Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes**

During the month, Registrations of 65 schools for participating in National Youth Parliament Schemes were reviewed and out of them, registrations of 16 schools were approved. Remaining 49 schools have been asked additional information for registration. During the month, 905 certificates issued.

- **National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)**

During the month of April, 2022

1. Capacity Building /Virtual Trainings & Workshops

- a. A resource team comprising of the two officers was deputed to visit Uttar Pradesh Assembly to conduct a two-day orientation workshop on 27th-28th April, 2022 to acquaint officers/officials of Legislature/NIC/Departments with various NeVA Modules.

- b. A 2 day (21st -22nd April 2022) online training workshop through video conferencing was done by CPMU, NeVA for Sikkim Legislative Assembly. The workshop was organised to give an idea about NeVA software to various officials of Sikkim Assembly to enable them to use various modules of NeVA software. Clarification of their doubts was also given.

- c. A 2 day (20th and 25th April 2022) online training workshop through video conferencing was undertaken by CPMU, NeVA for Haryana Legislative Assembly to give them an idea about NeVA software and it's modules to various officials of the Assembly.

- d. Necessary support through telephonic/video conferencing mode was given by the technical team of CPMU, NeVA to help officials of various State Assemblies understanding various modules of NeVA software and new features of NeVA of this application.

A study visit by the Committee on Information and Technology in Rajya Sabha along with the officials of MoPA and the Department of Telecommunications (DoT), Ministry of Communications was undertaken from 30th April to 4th May, 2022 at Imphal, Guwahati and Shillong to study the features available under One Nation- One Application and their status of implementation in order to assess its suitability for its implementation in Rajya Sabha.
