Subject: - Monthly Summary for the month of August, 2022 of Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.

1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-

• **Meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs**

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs in its meeting held on Wednesday, the 10th August, 2022 decided that:-

1. The 9th Session of the 17th Lok Sabha and 257th Session of Rajya Sabha (Monsoon Session 2022) which were adjourned sine-die on Wednesday, the 10th August, 2022 be prorogued.
2. The Cabinet Committee also ratified cases of Government's stand on Private Members Bills and Resolutions for being "Opposed or for requesting/persuading the Members concerned to withdraw the Bills/Resolution failing which they may be opposed /not to support", approved by the Minister for Parliamentary Affairs under the power delegated to him.

• **Prorogation of Both Houses**

Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha which commenced their 9th Session and 257th Session respectively on the 18th July, 2022, have been prorogued by the Hon'ble President on the 17th August, 2022.

• **Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

From 1956 to July, 2022 a total of 98213 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57531 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 1000 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 636 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of August, 2022, 50 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 55 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

During the month of August, 2022, 21 Implementation Reports were laid in Lok Sabha and 7 Implementation reports were laid in Rajya Sabha.

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- **Functioning of Consultative Committees**

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees is advisory. At present 39 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

In the month of August, 2022 –

- a. 09 Meetings of Consultative Committee were held.
- b. Names of 07 Member of Parliament have been deleted from various Consultative Committees after their death/Retirement during this month.
- c. 18 Member of Parliament nominated on various Consultative Committees by Government during the month.

- **Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes**

- a. 2nd Edition of portal based National Youth Parliament Scheme (NYPS) was launched on 1st August, 2022.
- b. Lecture on modalities of conducting Youth Parliament was delivered on 5th August, 2022 to guide teachers/officers of SCERT, Haryana for organizing Youth Parliament Competition, 2022-23 in the state of Haryana.

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- c. In the month of August, 2022 total 260 institutions have uploaded photographs, videos, report, student details etc on NYPS Portal after conducting the Youth Parliament sitting. 12375 students participated in these Youth Parliament Sittings.
- d. Kendriya Vidyalaya, Mathura Cantt., Mathura has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav on 26th August, 2022. Certificate of participation has been issued to all the participating students.
- e. Govt. Co. Ed. Sr. Sec School, Paschim Vihar, Delhi has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 30th August, 2022.
- f. JNV Narmada, Gujarat has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 29th August, 2022.
- g. Last date for organizing Group Level Evaluations of 16th National Youth Parliament Competition, 2019-20 for universities/colleges has been extended till 30th September, 2022.
- **National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)**

During the month of August, 2022 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

1. Milestone in NeVA implementation

- a. Central Project Monitoring Unit (CPMU) deputed its officials to Haryana Vidhan Sabha for conducting a mock session on 8th August, 2022. Hon. Chief Minister, Haryana launched NeVA at the start of the Monsoon Session. During the Session, Assembly transacted its business using the NeVA platform and thus joins the pool of digital legislatures through NeVA.

2. Capacity Building Programme for Stakeholders

- a. CPMU NeVA organised an Orientation programme on NeVA for MLAs of Meghalaya Legislative Assembly on 18th August, 2022 at Shillong.
- b. A Virtual Conference with Uttar Pradesh Assembly officials was convened on 23rd August, 2022 for end to end integration of NeVA by Assembly Officials.
- c. Three-day workshop was organised for Mizoram Legislative Assembly by the CPMU from 24th to 26th August, 2022 in which 9 Technical sessions along with their concerned query resolution were delivered to Mizoram Assembly Officials.

3. Developments/Up-gradation in NeVA application

- a. Feature of Multilingual Public Portal in respective State/UT language is updated.
- b. The 'Notice flow has been provisioned with multiple signatories and allows/disallow features have been added to Speaker/Chairman login.
- c. Auto generation of Reports for time investment in house, has been added in Content Management System (CMS) Secretary Login. The 'Dynamic Event' and 'Time Update facility' in the House Controller Module have also been added.
