Subject: - Monthly Summary for the month of July, 2022 of Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.

1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-

The 9th Session of 17th Lok Sabha and 257th Session of Rajya Sabha (Monsoon Session, 2022) commenced on Monday, the 18th July, 2022.

- **Bills Introduced in Lok Sabha**
(a) The Family Courts (Amendment) Bill, 2022

- **Bill Passed in Lok Sabha.**
(a) The Indian Antarctic Bill, 2022
(b) The Family Courts (Amendment) Bill, 2022
(c) The National Anti-Doping Bill, 2021.

- **Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

From 1956 to June, 2022 a total of 98193 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57527 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 987 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 572 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of July, 2022, 20 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 4 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

During the month of July, 2022, 252 Implementation Reports were laid in Lok Sabha and 161(13 Parts) Implementation reports were laid in Rajya Sabha.

- **Functioning of Consultative Committees**

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees is advisory. At present 39 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

In the month of July, 2022 –

- (a) 06 Meetings of Consultative Committee were held.
- (b) Names of 40 Member of Parliament have been deleted from various Consultative Committees after their death/Retirement during this month.
- (c) 13 Member of Parliament nominated on various Consultative Committees by Government during the month.

- **Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes**

- Orientation Course of 33rd National Youth Parliament Competition for Kendriya Vidyalayas, 2022-23 was held on 13th, 14th & 15th July, 2022.
- Orientation Course of 24th National Youth Parliament Competition for Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas, 2022-23 was held on 21st & 22nd July, 2022.
- Orientation Course of 55th Youth Parliament Competition for Delhi Schools, 2022-23 was held on 7th July, 2022.
- Registration for 1st Edition of online Portal based National Youth Parliament Scheme was closed on 31st July, 2022.
- 40 Institutions have conducted the Youth Parliament sitting in the month of July, 2022 and upload photographs, videos, report, student details etc on NYPS Portal. 1485 Students participated in these Youth Parliament Sitting.
- St. Paul's School, Hauz Khas, New Delhi was conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav on 27th July, 2022. Certificate of participation has been issued to all the participating students
- JNV Alipurdwar has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 30th July, 2022.

During the month, Registrations of 172 schools for participating in National Youth Parliament Schemes were reviewed and out of them, registrations of 95 schools were approved. Registration of 02 school has been disapproved. Remaining 75 schools have been asked additional information for registration. During the month, 40 events were conducted and 1485 students participated.

- **National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)**

During the month of July, 2022 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

1. **Virtual Training Programme**

- a. One day technical assistance programme for Gujarat Legislative Assembly was organised by the Central Project Monitoring Unit (CPMU) to incorporate their requirements in the NeVA platform on 14th July, 2022.

2. **Training cum orientation workshop for Haryana Legislative Assembly Members/ Ministers**

- a. A Two day orientation workshop of National e-Vidhan Application was organised for Haryana Legislative Assembly, Chandigarh on 21-22nd July, 2022. The Workshop was inaugurated by Sh. Manohar Lal Khattar, Hon. Chief Minister Haryana and Gian Chand Gupta, Hon. Speaker of Haryana Vidhan Sabha.
- b. Several Cabinet Ministers and Members of Legislative Assembly were imparted training and hands on experience of NeVA modules during this workshop. After this workshop, Haryana Vidhan Sabha decided to conduct paperless proceedings of the assembly through NeVA for the ensuing session.

3. **Various Issues taken up by CPMU**

- a. Various concerns/queries of UP assembly were resolved by the CPMU, NeVA and meeting with the NIC officials was took place to incorporate their requirements in NeVA platforms.

- **Protocol and Welfare (P&W)**

During the month, on 17th July, 2022 all party meeting was organized as a preparation for the Monsoon Session, 2022. On 19th July, 2022 all party meeting was organized to brief the floor leaders on “ **Current Situation of Sri Lanka**”
