1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-

· Meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs in its meeting held on Monday, the 13th June, 2022, considered this Ministry's Note No 04/2022 dated 13th June, 2022 regarding summoning of Monsoon Session, 2022 and approved that both Houses of Parliament may be summoned for its Monsoon Session, 2022 on Monday, the 18th July, 2022 and subject to exigencies of Government Business, the Session may conclude on Friday, the 12th August, 2022.

· Implementation of Assurances in Parliament

From 1956 to May, 2022 a total of 98193 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57527 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 1200 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 725 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of June, 2022, no Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha proceedings.

Functioning of Consultative Committees

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees is advisory. At present 39 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

In the month of June, 2022 -

- a. 05 Meetings of Consultative Committee were held.
- b. 01 Member of Parliament nominated on a Consultative Committees by Government during the month.

· Motivating Youth through Youth Parliament Schemes

During the month, Registrations of 205 schools for participating in National Youth Parliament Schemes were reviewed and out of them, registrations of 120 schools were approved. Registration of 01 school has been disapproved. Remaining 84 schools have been asked additional information for registration. During the month, 26 events were conducted and 956 students participated.

National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)

During the month of June, 2022 the following activities were undertaken -

1. Virtual Training Programme

a. A two-day online training cum workshop programme was organised for the Gujarat Legislative Assembly officials from 2-3rd June, 2022. The officials were demonstrated with the various modules of the NeVA and their queries were resolved by the CPMU.

2. Phase-II workshop for Meghalaya Legislative Assembly

a. The Meghalaya Legislative Assembly deputed some officials to the Central Project Monitoring Unit (CPMU), Delhi for Phase-II training cum workshop programme organised from 15-17th June, 2022 at CPMU, Parliament House Annexe, Delhi. During this visit, the officials were imparted the training of all NeVA modules and provided with handholding practice of these modules.

3. Empowered Committee Meetings

a. The 9th virtual meeting of Empowered Committee of National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) for Digital Legislature was held on 24th June, 2022 to consider and sanction the NeVA project for the Gujarat Assembly.

The Empowered Committee headed by Secretary, Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs approved the project amounting to ₹ 13,06,13,200/-, subject to their supplementary demand being made and to be considered as per the rules.

b. The 10th virtual meeting of Empowered Committee of National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) for Digital Legislatures was held on 29th June, 2022 to consider and sanction the NeVA project for Jharkhand Legislative Assembly. The Empowered Committee headed by Secy, MoPA approved the project amounting to ₹ 8,02,48,250/- for Jharkhand Assembly.

4. Study Visit of Rajya Sabha Committee on Information and Communication Technology to Chennai, Hyderabad and Goa

- a. A Study Visit of the Committee on Information and Communication Technology Management in Rajya Sabha under the Chairmanship of Shri Tiruchi Siva (Hon'ble M.P.) was undertaken along with the officials of the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs from 1st July, 2022 to 5th July, 2022.
- b. The Committee discussed the features under NeVA while focusing on the File No.1./12/2020-NeVA I/17995/2022 76 Artificial Intelligence (AI) related aspects and its use in machine translation and interpretation like Speech to text and text to other regional languages, etc. in Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly, Telangana Legislative Assembly and Goa Legislative Assembly.

5. Various Issues taken up by CPMU

- a. For the procedural establishment of the Disaster Recovery server site at Hyderabad a virtual meeting was held on 7th June, 2022. In the meeting various prospects of DR site were discussed between the stakeholders.
- b. A virtual meeting for establishment & setup of Data Center for NeVA was held on 9 th June, 2022. In this meeting, the supportive and establishment roles of stakeholders involved were discussed.
- c. On demand of Odisha Legislative Assembly, a virtual meeting for discussing the various technical issues related to NeVA was organised on 21st June, 2022. The Odisha Assembly submitted their technical issues which are being constantly resolved by the CPMU Team.
- d. The Haryana Legislative Assembly has requested to change the flow of Questions/Notices/Bills. To accomplish their request the CPMU team is providing their support.
- e. The CPMU team has updated the new feature of adding state specific logo on the NeVA public portal.
