**1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-**

• **Implementation of Assurances in Parliament**

From 1956 to August, 2022 a total of 98263 Assurances were culled out in Lok Sabha and 57586 Assurances were culled out in Rajya Sabha. Out of these 975 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 623 Assurances of Rajya Sabha are pending.

During the month of September, 2022, 20 Assurances were culled out from Lok Sabha proceedings and 15 Assurances were culled out from Rajya Sabha proceedings.

• **Functioning of Consultative Committees**

Informal Consultative Committees were constituted for various Ministries/Departments of Government of India, first time in the year 1954 to provide opportunities to Members of Parliament to have some glimpse into the working of the Government. Nature of these Committees is advisory. At present 39 Consultative Committees are functioning for various Ministries.

In the month of September, 2022 –

- a. 04 Meetings of Consultative Committee were held.
- b. 26 Members of Parliament nominated on various Consultative Committees by Government during the month.

In the month of September, 2022, total 121 institutions have registered on NYPS portal. 25 institutions have fully or partially uploaded photographs, videos, report, student details etc on NYPS Portal after conducting the Youth Parliament sitting. 1173 students participated in these Youth Parliament sittings.
  - b. Kendriya Vidyalaya, NDA Khadakwasala, Pune has conducted a special sitting of Youth Parliament on the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. Certificates of participation have been issued to all the participating students.
- **National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)**

During the month of September, 2022 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

1. **Meghalaya Legislative Assembly goes live through NeVA platform –**

- a. Officials from Central Project Monitoring Unit, NeVA were deputed to Meghalaya Vidhan Sabha from 9<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2022 to 16<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2022 so as to assist the Meghalaya Assembly to successfully run their session using NeVA platform.
- b. Training was also given to MLAs and officials so as to enable them to effectively use NeVA application.
- c. The Meghalaya Vidhan Sabha transacted its business through NeVA platform during its Monsoon Session from 9<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2022 and thus entered the pool of paperless legislatures using NeVA platform.

2. **Uttar Pradesh Legislative Council goes live through NeVA platform –**

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a. Officials from Central Project Monitoring Unit, NeVA were deputed to UP Legislative Council from 19th Sep, 2022 to 23rd Sep, 2022 so as to assist the Council to successfully run their session using NeVA platform.

b. 4 sessions were also conducted for 4 groups of MLCs to train them in NeVA software application.

**3. Support given to Mizoram Assembly for running there session on NeVA platform-**

a. Mizoram Assembly conducted its session from 6th – 8th Sep, 2022 using NeVA platform. In this context, necessary support was given to the Assembly by the CPMU NeVA team so that the session could be conducted in a hassle free manner.
